- 2016 Budget
 - Last year's tax returns - expenses
 - Tax prep
 - Background check
 - Website
 - Pensra
 - Meeting rooms
 - Registrars
 - Role of redwood league in the future – potential proposals
 - Referee training reimbursement by redwood?
 - Club pays \$300 to state for instructor, space
 - About 8 classes per year within our clubs
 - Pensra supplement instructor pay?
 - Coach licensing – RWL used to pay up to D license
 - 4v4 or 5v5 league
 - Sundays after Easter
 - Partner for playdates
 - Teddy will help organize for spring
 - Sunnysvale on board
 - Helping with turf fields or with lights
 - Originally designed to help with small portion of matching funds; certain percentage up to 50k
 - Request to look-up documentation for pending \$50-75,000 donation for 6 field Earthquakes complex
 - Fee Structure committee – PENSRA, Registration, Field Scheduling
 - Charged \$15 per player, but cost was \$14.50/\$18.50 depending on age group
 - \$30 per team
 - Need to revisit cost structure depending on the proposals from group
 - Separate meeting for budget committee
 - Gotsoccer registration
 - Will use it this spring
 - Pilot with virtual game cards on app for U8/U9
 - Redwoodsoccer.org website
 - Four clubs currently use field scheduling right now
 - Website costs \$4100/yr for current registration and field scheduling
 - Registration is coming off website so cost drops to \$3000
 - Can gotsoccer be used for field scheduling?

- Redwood league will cover for next year pending options for field scheduling in getsoccer
- Updates on spring leagues
 - CRL – winner qualifies directly into Far West Regionals; U13 and older qualifies to play in National League
 - National League has mandatory tournament which conflicts with High School
 - Get ODP classification?
 - Norcal teams can play in spring open premier
 - Don't need CY passes
- Redwood league programs?
 - League level team for U18/19 for fall?
- Pensra BOD – March 12th RWL rep – 4 meetings per year
- D2 BOD Report
 - 6 field complex
 - 17 leagues are donating in D2 (\$1.4 in the bank so far); RWL hasn't paid yet
 - Potential for pre-pay practice space
