Coaching Courses

Palo Alto Soccer Club is offering E and F courses in June, check the PASC website.

Redwood League will hold an E/D course Fri-Sat-Sun Jul 12-14 plus Jul 19-21. If you will have a U16 Class 1 team by next year, then you should get on the licensing track NOW, as you can only get one upgrade per year. The license progression is F -> E -> E/D -> D. By Fall-2003, anyone coaching Class 1 team U1 or older will have to have an E/D license. Note that you must have a Coaching E license and a USSF Level 8 Referee license to take the E/D course. They might allow you to take the referee class after the coaching class.
